No	Brewery	Beer	Region	ABV	Description
1	Ayr	Rabbie's Porter	Scotland	4.3	The nose has roast coffee, gingerbread and chocolate. The palate is of currant fruit and molasses becoming creamier towards the long warming finish.
2	Baa	Baa Humbug Winter Ale	Wales	5.7	Brewed stronger with a slightly sweeter spicier taste. Baa's darkest beer is just right for those long winter nights.
3	Barlow	Dark Horse	Derbyshire	4.2	A dark bitter, brewed with English malts to give its dark colour and coffee aroma. English hopped.
4	Bath Ales	Bath Gem	Bristol	4.1	Pale brown best bitter with sweet fruit and malt flavours and a hint of caramel. Little aroma but a balanced taste with a short, bitter finish.
5	Betteridge	Private Sector	Hampshire	4.2	A full-flavoured amber coloured ale using traditional English hops to provide a fully satisfying English best bitter.
6	Binghams	Vanilla Stout	Berkshire	5.0	Dark stout brewed using dark malts and infused with vanilla pods. Won gold in the CAMRA Supreme Champion Beer of Britain 2016 after winning gold in the Speciality Beer category.
7	Black Cat	Nine Tails	East Sussex	4.9	A winter warmer or perhaps 'Old Ale' that has proven to be so popular that it is brewed throughout the year. Full-flavoured dark beer from the generous crystal and chocolate malt with a bitter finish.
8	Blue Monkey	Howler	Nottinghamshire	4.5	A fruity dark beer with British and German malts generously hopped with German and American varieties to give a dark yet hoppy flavour and a lush lingering aroma!
9	Boss	Black	Wales	5.0	Give yourself to the dark side and allow yourself to be beckoned towards this velvety, silky stout seducer. This dark, devilish enticer has a rich, deep character that packs a chocolatey and nutty hit.
10	Bosuns	Tell No Tales	West Yorkshire	3.8	Traditional mild, smooth and dark with a complex blend of roasted malts.
11	Bradford	Northern Soul	West Yorkshire	3.8	A deep golden ale made using the finest English hops. Balance is not too strong, not too sweet or dry. Caramel and malty goodness set against fresh hops with a smooth mouthfeel, creamy white head and a subtle bitter aftertaste.
12	Bragdy Twt Lol	Cymryd y Pyst	Wales	4.4	A seasonal rugby special beer, which translated literally means 'Taking the Posts' in English. Dark brown, smooth tasting with a very light dry hop finish.
13	Brew Shack	5 A Day IPA	Dorset	5.5	A traditional English-style IPA with big resinous hoppy flavours and aroma.
14	Brew Shack	8 Grain Porter	Dorset	5.0	A sweet brown porter with a complex roasted malt flavour.
15	Brewsmith	Anvil Ale	Greater Manchester	4.5	Hoppy darker bitter with green bullet, chinook, challenger, calypso and galaxy hops.
16	Cerne Abbas	Gurt Coconuts Rum Stout	Dorset	7.6	Festival strength milk stout. A gentle giant of a beer full of oaty goodness and rum coconut depth of character that makes this enchanting beer "the best beer Polly Gabe has ever had".
17	Cerne Abbas	Responsibly	Dorset	3.2	Please drink responsibly.
18	Chadwicks	Castle Pale	Cumbria	4.2	A pale, straw coloured beer with a citrusy taste and aroma from American hops and a pleasant dry finish.
19	Chiltern	Bodger's Barley Wine	Buckinghamshire	8.5	A golden chestnut ale with citrus fruits, juicy malt and spicy hops. A unique style of beer with 'hop wine' overtones. Brewed in the style of a very strong IPA.
20	Crossed Anchors	Dark Glitch	Devon	3.7	A session dark ale with cedar, honey and fruit flavours and a citrus hoppy hit.
21	Dancing Duck	Donald Duck	Derbyshire	4.2	Heavily hopped with three varieties from New Zealand, this pale beer has a complex flavour with notes of tangerine, gooseberry, vanilla and lime.
22	Derby	Penny's Porter	Derbyshire	4.6	A rich, very dark, robust brew with a fine hop balance.
23	Dorset Brewing Company	Dorset Knob	Dorset	3.9	This light amber coloured medium bodied ale leaves a hint of fruit and vanilla on palate and a floral citrus aroma.
24	Dorset Brewing Company	Dusk Til Dawn	Dorset	3.7	American style IPA, with pronounced citrus flavours and a bold hoppy aroma.
25	Dynamite Valley	Ole Smokey	Cornwall	4.7	Rich, smokey stout, with a hint of dried fruit. Packed full of flavour and mouthfeel.
26	Eight Arch	Parabolic	Dorset	4.5	Award-winning pale ale brewed with U.S. hops to give fresh floral and grapefruit notes.
27	Eight Arch	Session	Dorset	3.8	Crisp and easy drinking Session IPA. A simple malt base allows ever changing hop combinations to shine, backed up by a firm bitterness.
28	Errant	Tusk	Tyne and Wear	5.2	A very drinkable amber IPA using pale malt blended with citrus cascade hops and powerful chinook to finish.
29	Exmoor	Beast	Somerset	6.6	A full-bodied dark porter. Brewed with a mix of pale ale, chocolate and crystal malts, and hopped. Lush rich aromas of coffee, treacle, toffee, fruit and chocolate swirl above the glass with additional aromas on the palate of fruit cake and rum.
30	Firebrick	Toon Broon	Tyne and Wear	4.6	A brown ale, deep amber in colour, carries a slight sweetness in its malt character and a nutty liquorice dimension too.
(31)	Five Points	Railway Porter	London	4.8	A porter with aromas of chocolate and coffee and hints of caramel, brewed with British East Kent goldings hops.
32	G2	Southern Cross	Kent	4.8	A premium beer with a tropical taste and delicious spicy undertone. A golden ale that leaves a big impression.
33	George Wright	Mild	Merseyside	4.0	George Wright's very own dark, creamy mild.
34	Ghost	Phantom	West Yorkshire	5.3	This shadowy IPA will give you goose bumps. One sip and its unmistakable taste made up of tempting malts, heaped with chewy, resinous hops will mysteriously appear on your taste buds from nowhere.
35	Great Western	Moose River	Bristol	5.0	Golden in colour, first impressions are crisp grapefruit with undertones of caramel. The nose is a lemon-sweet mix that works well to entice another sip! A delicious full-bodied American Pale Ale.
36	Greenmill	Old Git	Cheshire	4.2	A refreshing golden ale with a fusion of American and Slovakian hops.
37	Gyle 59	Brads Coffee Stout	Dorset	4.5	A collaboration with Finca, a specialist coffee roaster and café in Dorchester. The beer was developed by our assistant brewer, Bradley. A gentle stout with a subtle and refreshing coffee aroma and taste.
38	Gyle 59	Tropical Thunder	Dorset	3.7	This session ale brewed in collaboration and using plants from the Abbotsbury Subtropical Gardens to celebrate the gardens 250th anniversary has an unusual twist and a refreshing edge to the beer and a gentle warmth to the aftertaste.
39	Hammerpot	Mosaic Pale	West Sussex	4.1	Brewed with extra pale kilned English maris otter barley and American mosaic hops. The result is a crispy, hoppy, fruity pale ale with hints of lemon, peach, mango and pine.
40	High Weald	Greenstede Golden Ale	West Sussex	4.0	A refreshing golden beer, combining British and American hop varieties.
41	Hopcraft	Magnum Chaos	Wales	4.8	A mid-atlantic pale ale with a right old mix of hops you'd be right to expect some complexity from them but it's also fairly well balanced and gives a decent malty undertone to mix with the bitter, spicy, fruity hop charge.
42	Hophurst	Campfire	Greater Manchester	3.9	A dark mild with a smoky malty taste that emits aromas of roasted coffee and chocolate. The quality malted barley gives it its velvety finish.
43	Incredible Brewing Company	Rye Beer	Bristol	5.2	Pepper, biscuit, hopped, fresh, tropical fruit, lime.
44	Isle of Avalon	Hay Tosser	Somerset	4.6	Brewed as a one-off for Ellis Ford, who was jointly responsible for selecting all the real ales for Dorchester Beerex, this tawny beer is more malty than happy.
45	Kent	Brewers Reserve	Kent	5.0	A strong hop flavour of citrus and resin with a delicate malt background.

46	Knops	California Common	Scotland	4.6	Deep golden in colour. Initial malt sweetness balanced by bitterness, light toffee notes followed by a lingering secondary bitterness hit that is refreshing.
47	Larkins	Pale	Kent	4.2	A full-flavoured Kentish-style pale ale, packed with hops grown on Larkins Farm and with not a hint of grapefruit!
48	Lyme Regis	Miller's Mild	Dorset	3.6	A dark brown traditional tasting mild with notes of vanilla and chocolate. Just like your dad liked to drink.
49	Lyme Regis	Tempest	Dorset	5.4	A winter ale. Ruby in colour with a delicious, smooth and malty taste.
50	Mad Dog	Stouty McStoutFace	Wales	4.5	A classic stout. Full-bodied and smooth with chocolate and roast flavours from the hefty six malt base.
51	Madrigal	Severed Hand	Devon	4.1	A velvety porter furnished with raw cacao nibs.
52	Malt	Missenden Pale Ale	Buckinghamshire	3.6	A light amber easy to drink session ale.
53	Manning	Cave-man	Cheshire	4.2	An extremely well balanced bitter with a refreshing hop character. You'll find some blackberry aromas from the brambling cross, and a lasting gentle bitterness.
54	Marble	Chocolate Marble	Greater Manchester	5.5	Using chocolate malt, this beer has a rich, coffee like aroma and a full luxuriant mouthfeel with flavours of mocha, raisin, dried fruit and chocolate.
55	Market Harborough	Premium Brown	Leicestershire	5.1	A modern brown ale with chocolate and caramel malt flavours. Hopped with American galena and cascade.
(56)	Mauldons	Christies Golden Ale	Suffolk	3.9	A light, golden and hoppy refreshing beer.
57	Mordue	Radgie Gadgie	Tyne and Wear	4.8	Premium strength northern ale balancing leafy hops, berry fruit and malt.
58	Nethergate	Old Growler	Essex	5.0	A complex, satisfying porter, smooth and distinctive. Roast malt and fruit feature on the palate and the finish is powerfully hoppy. A twice Overall Champion at the CAMRA Winter Beer Festival.
59	Nottingham	Dreadnought	Nottinghamshire	4.5	A rich ruby coloured premium bitter with a well-rounded fullness of malt and deep strength of hop bitterness.
60	Palmers	200	Dorset	5.0	A big beer with a touch of caramel sweetness adding to a complex hoppy fruity taste that last from the aroma well into the aftertaste.
61	Palmers	Best	Dorset	4.2	Hop aroma and bitterness stay in the background in this predominantly malty best bitter, with some fruit on the nose.
62	Palmers	Copper	Dorset	3.7	Beautifully balanced, copper-coloured light bitter with a hoppy aroma.
63	Palmers	Dorset Gold	Dorset	4.5	More complex than many golden beers thanks to a pleasant banana and mango fruitiness on the aroma that carries on into the taste and aftertaste.
64	Palmers	Tally Ho!	Dorset	5.5	A dark old ale with a cult following. Roast malts and treacle toffee on the palate lead into a long lingering finish with more than a hint of coffee.
65	Penzance	Scilly Stout	Cornwall	7.0	A beer of incredible complexity with taste layers which change and develop as you work your way down the glass.
66	Piddle	Bent Copper	Dorset	4.8	Full-bodied English strong bitter. Made from the finest dark crystal barley and English hops to create an arresting malty flavour with aromas of herbs and freshly cut grass.
67	Piddle	Mad Hare	Dorset	4.7	Bright gold in colour, hops are added every five minutes during the 90 minute boil making it wonderfully complex. Unusual but moreish.
68	Rammy	Nihon Hana	Greater Manchester	5.3	Sorachi ace Hopped IPA, full-bodied and very hoppy.
69	Ramsgate	No.5	Kent	4.4	The aroma is toffee malt and fresh green hops with a full body and lingering bitter finish.
70	Rowton	Moonstruck Mild	Shropshire	3.3	A traditional dark mild.
71	Shiny Brewery	Affinity	Derbyshire	4.6	Strong Golden Bitter with lots and lots of fruity citra hops. Took Gold for SIBA National Champion Beer (Strong Bitters).
72	Sixpenny	6d Black	Dorset	4.4	A honey porter rich and full-flavoured, brewed with chocolate and brown malt, smooth, dark and delicious.
73	Sixpenny	IPA	Dorset	5.2	A superb example of an IPA. Strong and full of citrus flavours. A regular favourite and award winning ale.
74	Small Pauls	Dave's Arabica Stout	Dorset	5.2	A coffee oatmeal stout using chocolate malt, roasted barley and rolled oats with some "coffee". A slightly sweet taste brewed especially for the bar manager, Dave Harris.
75	Small Pauls	Winter Noggin	Dorset	5.5	An amber, fruity and strong bitter. Plenty of malt flavours and medium bitterness.
76	St Austell	Proper Job	Cornwall	4.5	Floral aromatic hops greet the nose and persist in the mouth, but are mellowed by a sweet well-rounded and full-bodied palate that disappear in a bittersweet aftertaste.
77	St Ives	Brewhouse Belgian	Cornwall	7.3	Strong belgian style wheat beer. Cloudy with a zesty tone and dry hopped finish.
78	Surfing Monkey	Hang Ten Tamarin	Wales	4.0	An amber coloured session ale, malty but ending with delightful linger of fruit, spice and bitterness.
79	Tanners	Box O' Frogs	Somerset	4.0	Hop-rich American-style pale ale. Flowery spicy notes and a hint of grapefruit with rich bitterness compensated with a pleasant maltiness.
80	Totally Brewed	Punch In The Face	Nottinghamshire	4.8	Amber in colour, fruity in flavour. Slap in the face's big brother! Packed full of American hops that pack a wallop!
81	Windswept	1806	Scotland	5.0	Pitch black, this classic Scottish stout is rich in coffee flavour with a good roasted barley finish.
82	Wishbone	Abbyss	West Yorkshire	4.3	Rich and dark where the malts do the talking with restrained hopping at session strength.
83	Wolf	Wolf Ale	Norfolk	3.9	Copper coloured ale with lots of bite! Goldings and challenger hops combined with locally grown malt make this a glorious full bodied brew.
84	Worsthorne	Old Trout	Lancashire	4.5	A red/brown ale - this beer is beautifully balanced, lightly bittered and very smooth to drink.
85	Wriggle Valley	Night Owl	Dorset	4.6	A rich velvety porter, with massive flavours of molasses, liquorice and a hint of smoke with a fruity nose.
86	Wriggle Valley	Ryme Nomad	Dorset	4.2	Best bitter with moderate bitterness and caramel.
87	Yorkshire Heart	Molly's Chocolate Stout	North Yorkshire	7.0	Dark stout and full-bodied with smooth chocolate flavours.
C1	Burrow Hill	Medium Dry	Somerset	6.0	Made on a hill overlooking the orchards of the Somerset Levels.
C2	Dorset Nectar	Hunny Bubble	Dorset	3.8	Flavoured with west country honey.
C3	Dorset Nectar	Raspberry Kiss	Dorset	4.0	Flavoured with Devon raspberries.
C4	Dorset Nectar	Top O' The Hill	Dorset	5.0	Organic cider champion 2016.
C5	Dorset Star	Dabinett	Dorset	5.5	A single variety apple, bursting with flavour.
C6	Dorset Star	First Press	Dorset	5.5	Dry with lots of mouthfeel.
C7	Joe's of Purbeck	Cheeky Cherry	Dorset	4.0	Subtle cherry flavour.
C8	Joe's of Purbeck	Devil's Leaf	Dorset	6.0	Infused with nettles.
C9	Joe's of Purbeck	Posh Spice	Dorset	6.0	Contains spices: cinnamon, allspice, star anise, cloves, for a winter warmer.
C10	Lulworth Skipper	Dry Cider	Dorset	6.5	Matured in old wine barrels.
C11	Palmers	First Press	Dorset	5.5	A traditional still cider with a distinctive full flavour and refreshing bite.
C12	Snails Bank	Elderflower Gin & Tonic	Herefordshire	4.0	Subtle mixture of bitter and sweet.
C13	Snails Bank	Pip Ginger	Herefordshire	4.0	Flavoured with root ginger.
C14	West Milton	Medium Dry	Dorset	6.0	A blend of local apples.
